Crossmolina - A Brief History

Crossmolina Dr. Crokes G.A.A. Club - was affiliated to the County Board in 1887, in 1906 the club changed to Deel Rovers. The officers were Chairman, Fr. Eddie Doherty, C.C., Secretary Pat Rowland; Treasurer, Willie Joe Tolan. The big breakthrough for the club came in 1926 when the club won its first North Mayo Junior title defeating Ballina by 0-10 to 0-5 in Crossmolina and went on to capture the county title defeating Kiltimagh.

The last surviving member of the team, Johnny Lindsey, passed away in 1995. The County Junior title was regained again in 1931 when Peter Munnely captained the team. The club experienced a lean period on the playing fields until 1943 when the late Cannon Willie Davis came to town. He sparked off the revival with special emphasis on youth. The club won the North Mayo Juvenile and minor titles in 1943, the North Junior title in 1946 defeating Doohoma 1-4 to 1-3. The County Junior title was captured in 1947 defeating Garrymore in the final by 0-6 to 0-3 in MacHale Park. The team Captain was the late Sean Tansey who played county football for Roscommon and Sligo. The team went on to capture the first senior title in 1949. The Deel Rovers were defeated in two North Mayo Junior finals 1953 and 1954 by Belmullet after replays.

In 1955 the county Junior title was won once again, defeating Belmullet in the north final by 2-9 to 0-4 and Kiltimagh in the county final by 3-5 to 2-5. The team was captained by Dr. Mickie Loftus. The club qualified for the senior title in 1956 losing to Castlebar after a replay by 0-14 to 1-7.

In 1957 the Deel Rovers qualified for the final again, the opponents were East Mayo who were captained by the late Sean Flanagan. Defeat was the lot once again, the score was 1-7 to 0-7. The Deelsiders were back in the junior ranks in 1961 winning the North Junior final under the captaincy of Mattie Heffernan, defeating Belmullet by 3-5 to 2-3 in James Stephen's Park. The side advanced to the county final against Garrymore who were seeking their first Junior title. The south Mayo men took the honours 3-7 to 1-8. The side went a step further in 1962 winning the county junior title defeating The Neale 1-6 to 0-8 in the final at Castlebar. The team was captained by Tom Rochford, a Garda in the town and a native of Ballinrobe.

The club stepped down from the senior to intermediate in 1967 with little success and re-graded back to junior in 1972. Three years later the Deel Rovers captured the county junior title defeating Ballintubber by 3-7 to 0-12 in the team was captained by Christy Commons. Present Club Chairman Michael O'Malley, Secretary Tom McNulty were prominent members of that team.

In 1980 the intermediate team won a historic first title defeating Davitts Irishtown in the final by 1-7 to 0-6. The team captain was Peter Mangan. In 1985 present club president, Dr. Michael Loftus, was elected to the highest office as president of the Cuman Luthchleas Gael. This was a huge personal triumph and a great honour for the club. Through the wonderful commitment and dedication of our Bórd na nÓg officers over the years we have won every league title and championship there is possible to win at underage level in the past 20 years including County Minor titles in 1984, 1992 and 1993.

The senior team won the Super League in 1985, were defeated in the County finals of 1986 and 1988, before winning the historic second senior title in 1995, defeating Kiltane in the final by 0-11 to 0-7 under the guidance of manager, Greg Burke, and captained by Thomas Loftus. Under-21 titles were won in 1992 when defeating Charlestown by five points, 0-12 to 0-7, to win the first title at this level. Aiden Heffernan was the captain. In 1997 they collected their second title defeating Claremorris in Kiltimagh by 1-11 to 0-8 with Patrick Mc Andrew, Captain.

Crossmolina - A Brief History - Cont.

At Junior level the club did not enjoy much success since winning the 1975 title, reaching four finals in 1984, '85, '86 and '95 without success. finally in 1997 Crossmolina beat Ardagh in Knockmore to claim the North title. final score Crossmolina 2-9, Ardagh 0-8, with Aiden Heffernan as captain and retained it in 1998 by defeating Belmullet 1-6 to 0-7 under the captaincy of Peadar Flynn. The side also won the Division 4 league title in 1997 and the winter league title in 1998. The minor team won the 1998 North 'B' title defeating Ardnaree after a replay 2-7 to 0-8, Captained by Damien Syron.

In 1999 the senior title was won by Crossmolina for the third time, defeating Ballina by two points 0-9 to 0-7 at McHale Park. The winners played their first game in the Connaught Club Championship on the 7th November in Tuam against Galway champions Killarney. After a hard fought contest the greater all-round strength of the Mayo men saw them through on a scoreline of 0-12 to 0-7. Their opponents in the final were Roscommon Gaels at Hyde Park. In a heart-stopping encounter the sides finished level - 0-9 each. In the replay six days later at St. Tiernan's Park, Crossmolina captured their first Connaught Club title by a winning margin of 1-7 to 0-5. Tom Nallen captained the side that day.

The senior league title was won for a fourth year in a row this year, winning all our 13 games in the process, and retained the senior title with a three point win over Burrishoole 0-14 to 0-11 in McHale Park, Tom Nallen was again captain of the side.

Crossmolina Selectors for 2000

Thomas Jordan is a manager of Crossmolina for the second successive year, having guided them to the county senior title and the Connaught Club Championship in his first year in charge. He has played for the club at all grades over the years and won an Intermediate Championship medal in 1980. From Ennisce, Thomas is employed as a prison officer in Castlereagh.

His selectors are Michael Moore and Padraic Syon. Michael is a former Galway goalkeeper, having played in the 1963 All-Ireland final against Dublin. He won a County Junior Championship medal with Crossmolina in 1975. He is a tremendously dedicated clubman and he has served as chairman of the club and he has also been a selector on a number of occasions in the past.

Padraig, from Keenagh is another great club servant who was a member of the 1975 Junior Championship winning team and the 1980 Intermediate Championship success. He has been associated with many of the successful underage teams produced by Crossmolina in recent years and he has also won an All Ireland over 40's medal with Mayo.

Crossmolina Coach

Jarlath Cunningham is a 32 year old instructor with Western Care from Castlebar. Jarlath started training the Crossmolina Team at the start of the '99 season, which turned out to be the greatest in the club's history. Jarlath is a great believer in discipline and his varied training programmes will not bore players over the long season.

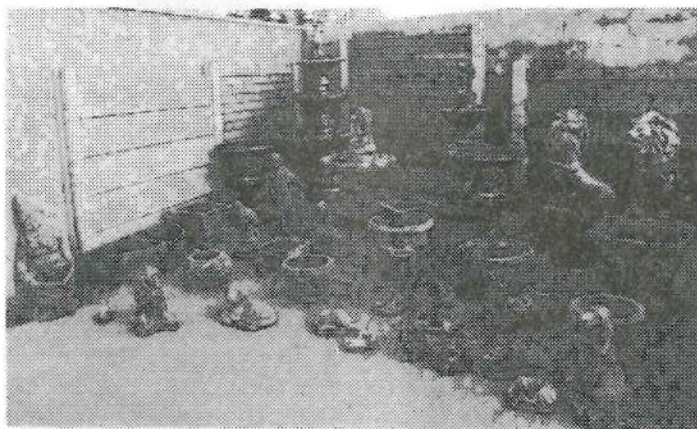

Bunninadden Management

James Kearins

James, a garda sergeant based in Ballymote, played senior inter-county football for Sligo from 1974 to 1987. He was corner forward on the Sligo team that won the Connaught title in 1975. He won four senior championship medals with St. Patrick's in 1973, '74, '88 and '89.

He was manager of the St. Patrick's Team From 1985 to 1988. He won an intermediate championship medal with Ballymote in 1996. He took over as joint manager of Bunninadden with Richard Brennan in 1999.

Richard Brennan

Richard, who is an agricultural contractor, has been involved with Bunninadden G.A.A. club at management level since 1991, first at intermediate level and then senior level; also St. Nathy's in which he won 2 county U-21 titles. Then as manager of Bunninadden on its own he won two intermediate league titles and last year the senior league title. It gives Richard great satisfaction to see his club win its first County Senior Championship since 1891.

BUNNINADDEN 1891

Bunninadden's only senior title was won on Sunday, May 3rd, 1891 in Phillip's Field, Collooney, when Bunninadden Emmets defeated Strandhill by 0-5 to 0-2.

In that era football teams were 17 a-side. Most of the training was done by moonlight as there was no time (due to hard work) to do it by day.

At half time every player was given a glass of poitin. Poitin and horse embrocation was used as a rub for injuries also. There was no physio in them times. Mark Gormley, a member of that team was great grandfather to the present Gormleys. Pat Coen, who hailed from Doocastle, was great grandfather of Paul Kerins, vice-captain of today's team.

Andrew Doyle was grandfather of Mick Marren, the former Bunninadden player and county player of the 1960's. Paddy Coen, Doocastle, grandson of Pat Coen holds the only surviving medal from that time.

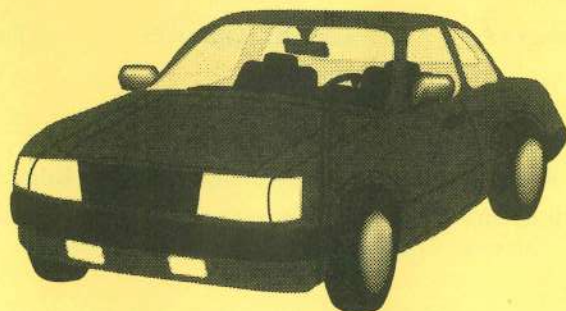

Sligo Men Who Played for Crossmolina

Sean Tansey (R.I.P.) Cloonacool

Played for Tubbercurry and won County Senior Championship Medals in 1938, '39 and '40 with them.

In 1944 he lined out with Roscommon Town late in 1945 he came to work in Crossmolina. His arrival sparked off a great period in the in the history of the club, winning the county junior final in 1974 and senior in 1949 Sean was captain of both teams.
